





Coding scheme

- The codes are alphanumeric
- ☐ The range → 1A00.00 to ZZ9Z.ZZ
- Categories now has 4 characters, and there are 2 levels of subcategories.
- The coding scheme always has a letter in the second position to differentiate from the codes of ICD-10.

Coding scheme

- The first character of the code always relates to the chapter number.
- It may be a number or a letter.

- The code range of a single chapter always has the same character in the first position.
- No use of "I" and "O" in the code numbers

ICD-11 Term Explanation Foundation Underlying data base content that holds all information Linearization Content for specific purpose

Codes that can be used alone. A meaningful minimum of information Example: Gastritis > DA42

Stem code

Extension code More detail than is included in a stem code. They can never be used without a stem code, but are used together to define the full detail of a condition

Example: Acute > XT5R

Cluster coding Stem codes can be post-coordinated, or jointly used together, with extension codes or with other stem codes to fully describe one diagnosis

Example: Acute Gastritis → DA42&XT5R





The ICD entities in the Foundation Component

- Are not necessarily mutually exclusive
- Allow multiple parenting (i. e. an entity may be in more than one branch)
 - E.g. tuberculosis meningitis is both an infection and a brain disease



Multiple parenting: Primary and secondary parents

- The hierarchy of ICD-11 is defined the same as it was in previous versions of ICD.
- Multiple parenting was introduced to enable specific extracts of the Tabular list for medical specialties or for specific use cases.
 - For example: malignant neoplasm of the skin is located in the chapter for neoplasms
 - It was also defined in the skin chapter

Example: EE60.00 Ear-lobe keloid

- Primary parent: "Kleoid" from chapter 14 Diseases of the skin
- Secondary parent: "Noninflammatory disorders of external ear" from chapter 10 Diseases of the ear or mastoid process




Gray letter Place of secondary parent

The ICD Linearizations

- A linearization is a subset of the foundation component
- Fit for a particular purpose: reporting mortality, morbidity, or other uses
- Composed of entities that are Mutually Exclusive of each other
- Each entity is given a single parent
- Linearizations are similar to the classical print versions of ICD

Linearization Information Icons

- button shows which entities are located in which linearizations
 - The blue icon shows that the entity is included in the ICD-11 for Mortality and Morbidity Statistics
 - The yellow icon shows that the entity is included in the Primary Care High Resource Setting Linearization
- The green icon shows that the entity is included in the Primary Care Low Resource Setting Linearization



There are several buttons that you can use to decide how the visualizations appear. You need

This is the default mode and it will let you see:

- · the selected entity

This button can be used in conjunction with one of the other buttons.

Precoordination and Postcoordination, Cluster coding

- O A health condition may be described to any level of detail, by applying more than one code, or by 'postcoordinating' (i.e. combining):
 - two or more stem codes, (i.e. code1/code2)
 - stem codes with one or more extension codes.
 (i.e. stem code & extension code1 & extension code2)
- In this manner, the classification can address a large number of clinical concepts with a limited range of categories.

Post-coordination in the icd-11 browser

- Will be activated in linearization view
- Allows adding more detail to a category
- Different types of information can be added to different entities
- E.g. 2B72.0 Adenocarcinoma of stomach
 - Adding anatomy >> XA56K7 Gastric fundus

Description

An adenocarcinoma arising from the stomach glandular epithelium. Gastric adenocarcinoma is primarily a disease of older individuals. It most commonly develops after a long period of atrophic gastritis and is strongly associated with Helicobacter pylori infection. The lack of early symptoms often delays the diagnosis of gastric cancer. The majority of patients present with advanced tumours which have poor rates of curability. Microscopically, two important histologic types of gastric adenocarcinoma are recognised: the intestinal and diffuse type. The overall prognosis of gastric adenocarcinomas is poor, even in patients who receive a curative resection.






Displaying / Searching value sets of post -coordination

 - E.g. Histopathology, anatomy


